HYDROWAX is a water-based wax, which enhances gloss finishes and impart water resistant and stain resistant properties. It is made from anionically stabilized, acqeous dispersion of various waxes and additives, taking the best characteristics of each to make a superior quality liquid wax.

Major Uses:

HYDROWAX can be applied to almost any surface where a gloss finish is required and is particularly suitable as a finish coat for all MAS Stucco Venetian plasters. Hydrowax is a waterproof and user friendly with high performance that provides ultimate protection, while its liquid state allows the addition of colored pigment paste, metallic powders and other compatible fine art materials with ease.

Coverage rates: Smooth Finishes (Stucco, Grassello) Coverage rate approximately = 25 m²/liter

Coverage rate approximately = 8-12 m²/liter **Method of Application:**

Ensure that the polished plaster has been allowed to dry for 24 hours minimum.

HYDROWAX should be applied with a sponge, rag or spatula/wide putty knife in thin, even coats over an entire surface. It should be allowed to dry up to 12 hours before being buffed to a high sheen using a clean rag or mechanical buffer. As Hydrowax may become too thin to apply properly in hot weather, it may be chilled for a short time for more optimal application. Hydrowax is ready to use, touch dry in 1-3 hours.

Buff with a mechanical buffer to enhace the surface shine.

Keep material in a cool place below 25[°]C. Keep the container tightly closed. Shelf life of 12 months minimum.

Cleaning of Tools:

All tools should be cleaned with warmth water with soap.

Packing:

Available in 1 ltr.
