# SYNTHETIC MATT WHITE

#### **General Description:**

SYNTHETIC MATT WHITE is a finished coat based on synthetic resin used as a matt finish in alkyd system.

### **Application procedure:**

Substrate must be free from oil and other contaminants.

Sandblasting is required to Sa 2 ½, if sandblasting is not possible, manual wire brushing is recommended. Use Deruster to remove away rust and rinse with water and let it dry. Apply 1- 2 coats of red oxide primer by roller, brush or spray or 1 – 2 coats of under coat prior to the application of SYNTHETIC MATT WHITE.

#### Storage:

SYNTHETIC MATT WHITE should be kept in a cool area below 25°C. Keep in tightly closed container.

#### **Cleaning of Tools:**

All tools should be cleaned with Wash Thinner as soon as possible.

#### Packing:

Available in LTR and 1USG.

## Physiological Hazards:

SYNTHETIC MATT WHITE does not contain dangerous solvents, nevertheless, good ventilation in working rooms recommended as well as the use of safety tools and equipment.
